## **PRESENTER: Jon Freckleton, DO**



After graduating from University of Colorado, Dr. Freckleton returned to Steamboat for a year to prepare for and apply to medical school. During this time he helped coach at Winter Sports Club and raced bikes and skis. He decided to attend University of New England College of Osteopathic Medicine and moved to Maine to begin Medical School. His belief in the body's ability to heal itself with the aid of hands-on manipulation led him to specialize in traditional osteopathic medicine early on during medical school. After graduating from medical school Dr. Freckleton did his residency in Family Practice and Osteopathic manipulation with two years of study of rural primary care in Craig Colorado.
